Tournament Rules - SCOTCH DOUBLES MIXED CHAMPIONSHIP

- 1 **ELIGIBILITY:** Entries are open to all USBC Members.
- 2 **TYPE:** This handicap tournament will consist of a Two-player Mixed Team (1 male, 1 female). Six consecutive games shall be bowled on your starting lanes. Total pins plus handicap shall decide the winner. In case of a tie, co-champions will be declared and prizes will be combined and split equally between all tied bowlers.
- 3 **FORMAT:** Scotch doubles format consists of the female bowler rolling the first ball of the first frame. If she rolls a strike, the male bowler will roll the first ball of the second frame. If she does not roll a strike on the first ball of the first frame, the male bowler will roll the second ball of the first frame. The female bowler will then roll the first ball of the second frame, with the male bowler rolling at the spare if she does not strike, or he will bowl the first ball of the third frame if she does strike. This rotation continues for the rest of the game. Game two has the male bowler rolling the first ball of the first frame and the rotation will continue as stated above. The female bowler will start games one, three and five and the male bowler will start games two, four and six.
- 4 **OPTIONAL EVENTS:** Teams may enter the optional scratch event. The cost is \$10 per team and can be paid at check-in.
- 5 **Average Reporting Requirements:** Averages used will be determined in the following manner
A> Highest average from the previous season, 2021-2022. Summer and Winter averages of 21 or more games in a USBC certified league and does not include sport or composite averages.
B> If no average from the previous season as stated, then a current league average with 21 or more games in a USBC certified league and does not include sport or composite averages.
C> Bowlers who do not meet any of the above requirements will be entered with a 220 average.
D> Rule 319a, 319b and 319c apply. Rule 319d, 319e and 319f will not apply. If, at the time of bowling, entrant has a current league average of at least 21 games that is 10 pins or more higher, than the then the current average must be used. Better know as the 10-pin rule and it is in affect.
- 6 **HANDICAP:** The handicap will be 90% of the difference between the teams' average and 440. A bowler's average will cap at 220, no matter what the bowlers average is.
- 7 **MULTIPLE ENTRIES:** Bowlers may participate multiple times with the same or different partner, however a bowler may cash only once in the top five (5) with the same partner.
- 8 **REFUNDS:** No refund of entry fees can be made after reserve entries close, 02/04/2023.
- 9 **SUBSTITUTION:** Substitutes are allowed when replacement is necessary. The tournament office must be advised of the substitution at least one hour before the scheduled bowling time.
- 10 **TARDY PLAYERS:** Any player/team arriving after the squad has started will be allowed to bowl. Their score will be zero for all frames missed.
- 11 **ENTRY SCHEDULED:** Entries will be scheduled in the order they are received. The schedules will not be changed, except in case of emergency. Only Team captains are notified and permitted to make requests for a schedule change. Tournament Manager reserves the right to cancel a squad for lack of entries.
- 12 **ON-SITE ENTRIES:** On-site are allowed, subject to availability of lanes, up to one hour before the start of the squad. Entries with payment received before the tournament deadline will get squad choice and time preference over on-site entries.
- 13 **LINE-UPS:** All line-ups will be scheduled according to the order they appear on the entry form and will not be altered without permission from the tournament manager.
- 14 **DISPUTES:** Any questions or disputes not covered by these tournament rules and/or not specifically covered in the current USBC Rule Book will be decided by KCUSBC whose decisions are final.
- 15 **RULES VIOLATIONS:** Any violation of any USBC or these tournament rules will result in disqualification.
- 16 **PHOTO ID:** A current photo ID is required for check-in and for bracket/high game winnings collection.
- 17 **ENTRY REFUSAL:** KCUSBC reserves the right to refuse entrance to any team and/or individual.
- 18 **PAYOUT RATIO:** Payout ratio is 1 for 8 in for Team, Doubles and Singles events and 1 for 10 in All-Events.
- 19 **DRESS CODE:** Bowlers are required to wear appropriate attire when participating in this tournament. Skirts and slacks are preferred. Nice, clean jeans, shorts and leggings are allowed. Collared shirts are preferred, but bowling jerseys with no collar are allowed. Attire deemed inappropriate will not be allowed, such as, but not limited to, tank tops, sweat pants, work out clothes or pajama tops and/or bottoms.
- 20 **KCUSBC LIABILITY:** The entrants whose names appear herein, or their authorized replacements hereby agree that KCUSBC shall be liable only to the extent of returning any unused entry fees, if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through delay, unexpected yet necessary schedule changes, or premature termination of the tournament; which may be brought about by war, national emergency or emergencies of causes relating thereto or resulting there from fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of the tournament manager.
